






Nice prof. Interesting teaching style. Never left the class boring, the statistic stuff is boring though.






Great teacher, great teaching skills, and the T.A. (ALEX) also has good teaching skills for the lab.




Now I'm prepared for the 7015. Besides, I can run some codes by myself to analyze my own project.


This course allows me to better analyze the data of my thesis, and did good on my Exit Seminar presentation.

Great class, really helpful when it comes to doing my analysis.



(AG-09)What is your expected grade in this course?




(AG-10)What is your current LSU GPA?


